The In ecticide Act, 1968 (Act No.46 of 1968)

An Act to egulate the import, manufactu es, sale, t ansport, dist ibution and use of insecticides with a view to p event isk to human beings or animals and fo matte s connected the ewith. $[2^{nd}$ Septembe 1968]

Be it enacted by Pa liament in the Nineteenth Yea of the Republic of India as follows:

1. Sho t title, extent and commencement. *

- a. This Act may be called the Insecticides Act, 1968.
- b. It extends to the whole of India.
- c. It shall come into fo ce on such date as the Cent al Gove nment may, by notification in the official Gazette, appoint and diffe ent dates may be appointed for diffe ent States and fo diffe ent p ovisions of Act.

2. Application of othe laws not ba ed *

The p ovisions of this Act shall be in addition to, and not in de ogation of, any othe law fo the time being in force.

3. Definitions- In this Act, unless the context othe wise equi es-

- a. "animals" means animals useful to human beings and includes fish and fowl, and such kinds of wild life as the Cent al Gove nment may, by notification in the official Gazette, specify, being kinds which in its opinion, it is desi able to p otect or p ese ve;
- b. "Boa d" means the Cent al Insecticides Boa d constituted unde Sec.4;
- c. "Cent al Insecticides Laborato y" means the Cent al Insecticides Laborato y established, or as the case may be, the institution specified unde Sec.16;
- d. "Impo t" means b inging into any place within the te ito ies to which this Act extends f om a place outside those te itories;
- e. "Insecticide" means
 - i. any substance specified in the schedule; or
 - ii. such othe substances (including fungicides and (weedicides) as the Cent al Gove nment may, afte consultation with the Boa d, by notification in the official Gazette, include in the schedule f om time to time; or
 - iii. Any p epa ation containing any one or more of such substances;
- f. "Insecticide Analyst" means an insecticide analyst appointed unde Sec.19;
- g. "Insecticide Inspector" means an insecticide Inspecto appointed unde Sec. 20
- h. "Label" means any w itten, p inted o g aphic matte on the immediate package and on eve y othe cove ing in which the package is placed or packed and includes any w itten, p inted or g aphic matte accompanying the insecticide;

- i. "Licensing Office " means a licensing office appointed unde Sec.12;
- j. "Manufactu e" in elation to any insecticide, includes
 - i. any p ocess, or pat of a p ocess for making, alte ing, finishing, packing, labeling, b eaking up or othe wise t eating o adopting any insecticide with a view to its sale, dist ibution or use but does not include the packing or b eaking up of any insecticide in the o dina y cou se of etail business; and
 - ii. Any p ocess by which p epa ation containing an insecticide is formulated.
- k. "Misb anded"- an insecticide shall be deemed to be misb anded
 - i. If its label contains any statement, design or g aphic ep esentation elating the eto which is false or misleading in any mate ial pa ticula , o if its package is othe wise deceptive in espect of its contains; or
 - ii. If it is an imitation of, or is also unde the name of, anothe insecticide; o
 - iii. If its label does not contain a wa ning o caution which may be necessa y and sufficient, if complied with to p event isk to human beings or animals; o
 - iv. If any word, statement o othe info mation equi ed by o unde this act to appea on the label is not displayed the eon in such conspicuous manne as the othe wo ds, statements, designs or g aphic matte have been displayed on the label and in such te ms as to ende it likely to be ead and unde stood by any ordina y individuals unde customa y conditions of pu chase and use; or
 - v. If it is not packed o labeled as equi ed by or unde this Act; or
 - vi. If it is not egiste ed in the manne equi ed by or unde this Act, or
 - vii. If the label contains any efe ence to egist ation othe than the egist ation numbe ; o
 - viii. If the insecticide has a toxicity which is highe than the level p esc ibed or is mixed or packed with any substance so as to alte its natu e of quality or contains any substance which not included in the egist ation.
- I. "Package" means a box, bottle, gasket, tin, ba el, case, eceptacle , sack, bag, w appe , or othe thing in which an insecticide is placed o packed;
- m. "P emises" means any land, shop , stall o place whe e any insecticide is sold or manufactu ed o sto ed or used, and includes any vehicle ca ying insecticides;
- n. "P esc ibed" means p esc ibed by ules made unde this Act;
- o. "Registe ed", with its g ammatical va iations and cognate exp essions, means egiste ed unde this Act;
- p. "Sale", with its g ammatical va iations and cognate exp ession, means the sale of any insecticide whethe for cash or on c edit and whethe by wholesale o etail, and includes an ag eement fo sale, an offe for sale, the exposing for sale o having in possession for sale of any insecticide and includes also an attempt to sell any such insecticide;
- q. "State Gove nment", in elation to a Union te itory, means the administ ator the eof;
- . "Wo ke " means a pe son employed unde a cont act of se vice or app enticeship.

4. The Cent al Insecticides Boa d -

- 1. The Cent al Gove nment shall, as soon as may be, constitute a Boa d to be called the Cent al Insecticides Boa d to advise the Cent al Gove nment and State Gove nments on technical matte s a ising out of administ ation of this Act and to ca y out the other functions assigned to the Boa d by or under this Act.
- The matte s on which the Boa d may advise unde sub-section (1) shall include matte elating to *
 - a. The isk to human being or animals involved in the use of insecticides and the safety measu es necessa y to p event such isk;
 - b. The manufactu e, sale, sto age, t ansport and dist ibution of insecticides with a view to ensu e safety to human beings o animals.
- 3. The Boa d shall consist of the following membe s, namely:
 - a. The Di ecto -Gene al of Health Se vices, ex officio, who shall be Chai man;
 - b. The D ugs Cont olle , India, ex officio;
 - c. The Plant P otection Advise to the Gove nment of India, ex officio;
 - d. The Di ector of Sto age and Inspection, Minist y of Food, ag icultu e, Community Development and Co-ope ation, (Depa tment of Food) ex officio;
 - e. The Chief Advise of Factories, ex officio;
 - f. The Di ecto , National Institute of Communicable Diseases, ex-officio.
 - g. The Di ecto -Gene al, Indian Council of Ag icultu al Resea ch, ex officio;
 - h. The Di ecto -Gene al, Indian Council of Medical Resea ch, ex-officio;
 - i. The Di ecto , Zoological Su vey of India, ex officio;
 - j. The Di ecto -Gene al, Indian Standa ds Institution, ex officio;
 - k. The Di ector-Gene al of Shipping or, in his absence, the Deputy Di ector Gene al of Shipping, Minist y of T anspo t and Shipping ex officio.
 - I. The joint Di ector, T affic (Gene al) Minist y of Railways (Railway Boa d) ex officio;
 - m. The Sec eta y Cent al Committee for Food Standa ds, ex officio;
 - i. The Animal Husband y Commissione, Depa tment of Ag icultu e, ex-officio;
 - ii. The Joint Commissione (Fishe ies), Depa tment of Ag icultu e, ex officio;
 - iii. The Deputy Inspector-Gene al of Forests (Wild Life), Depa tment of Ag icultu e ex officio;
 - iv. The Indust ial Advise (Chemicals), Di ectorate-Gene al of Technical Development, ex officio)
 - n. One pe son to ep esent the Minist y of Pet oleum and Chemicals, to be nominated by the Cent al Gove nment.
 - o. One pha macologist to be nominated by the Cent al Gove nment.
 - p. One medical toxicologist to be nominated by the Cent al Gove nment,
 - q. One pe son who shall be in cha ge of the depa tment dealing with public health in a State, to be nominated by the Cent al Gove nment.

- . Two pe sons who shall be Di ectors of Ag icultu e in States, to be nominated by the Cent al Gove nment.
- s. Fou pe sons, one of whom shall be an expet in indust ial health and occupational haza ds, to be nominated by the Cent al Gove nment.
- t. One pe son to ep esent the Council of Scientific and Indust ial Resea ch, to be nominated by the Cent al Gove nment.
- u. One ecologist to be nominated by the Cent al Gove nment.
- 4. The pe sons nominated unde Clause. (xiv) to (xxi) inclusive of sub-section (3) shall, unless their seats become vacant ea lier by egist ation, death or othe wise, hold office for three years from the date of their nomination but shall be eligible for enomination.

P ovided that the pe sons nominated unde Cls. (xvii) and (xviii) shall hold office only fo so long as they hold the appointments by vi tue of which thei nominations we e made.

5. No act or p oceeding of the Boa d, the Regist ation Committee o any committee appointed unde Sec. 6, shall be called in question on the g ound me ely of the existence of any vacancy in, o any defect in the constitution of the Boa d, the Regist ation Committee o such committee, as the case may be.

5. Regist ation Committee

- The Cent al Gove nment shall constitute a Regist ation Committee consisting of a Chai man, and not more than five pe sons who shall be membes of the Boa d (including the D ugs Cont olle, India and the Plant P otection Advise to the Gove nment of India) *
 - a. To egiste insecticides afte sc utinizing thei formulae and ve ifying claims made by the importe o the manufactu e , as the case may be, as ega ds thei efficacy and safety to human beings and animals; and
 - b. To pe form such othe functions as a e assigned to it by or unde this Act.
- 2. Whe e the Chai man is not a membe of the Boa d, his te m of office and othe conditions of se vice shall be such as may be determined by the Cent al Gove nment.
- 3. Subject to the p ovisions of sub-section (2), a membe of the Regist ation Committee shall hold office for so long as he is a membe of the Boa d.
- 4. The Committee may also co-opt such numbe of expe ts and for such p opose or pe iod as it may deem it, but any expe t so co-opted shall have no ight to vote.
- 5. Regist ation Committee shall egulate its own p ocedu e and the conduct of the business to be t ansacted by it.

6. Othe Committee

The boa d may appoint such committees as it deems fit and may appoint to them, pe sons who a e not membe s of the Boa d to exe cise such powe s and pe form such duties as may, subject to such conditions, if any, as the Boa d may impose, be delegated to them by the Boa d.

7. P ocedu e fo Boa d

The Boa d may, subject to the p evious app oval of the Cent al Gove nment, make bylaws for the pu pose of egulation of its own p ocedu e and the p ocedu e of any committee the eof and the conduct of all business to be t ansacted by it or such committee.

8. Sec eta y and othe office s

The Cent al Gove nment shall *

- I. Appoint a pe son to be the Sec eta y of the Boa d who shall also function as Sec eta y to the Regist ation committee; and
- II. P ovide the Boa d and the Regist ation Committee with such technical and othe staff as the Cent al Gove nment conside s necessa y.

9. Regist ation of insecticides

1. Any pe son desi ing to impot or manufactu e any insecticide may apply to the Regist ation Committee fo the egist ation of such insecticide and the e shall be sepa ate application for each such insecticide:

P ovided that any pe son engaged in the business of import or manufactu e of any insecticide immediately befo e the commencement of this section shall make an application to the Regist ation Committee within a pe iod of (seventeen months) f om the date of such commencement fo the egist ation of any insecticide which he has been importing o manufactu ing before that date.

[P ovided fu the that whe e any pe son efe ed to in the p eceding p oviso fails to make an application unde that p oviso within the pe iod specified the ein, he may make such application at any time the eafte on payment of a penalty of one hund ed upees fo eve y month o pa t the eon afte the expi y of such pe iod for the egist ation of each such insecticide.]

- 2. Eve y application unde sub-section (1) shall be made in such fo m and contain such pa ticula s as may be p esc ibed.
- 3. On ecceipt of any such application for the egist ation of an insecticide, the Committee may, afte such enqui y as it deems fit and afte satisfying itself that the insecticide to which the application elates conforms to the claims made by the importe or by the manufactu e, as the case may be, as ega ds the efficacy of the insecticide and its safety to human beings and animals, egiste (on such conditions as may be specified by it) and on payment of such fee as may be p esc ibed, the insecticide, allot a egist ation numbe the eto and issue a ce tificate of egist ation in token the eof within a pe iod of twelve months f om the date of eceipt of the application :

P ovided that the Committee may, if it is unable within the said pe iod to a ive at a decision on the basis of the mate ials placed before it, extend the pe iod by a fu the pe iod of not exceeding six months.

P ovided fu the that if the Committee is of opinion that the p ecautions claimed by the applicant as being sufficient to ensu e safety to human beings or animals a e not such as can be easily obse ved or that notwithstanding the obse vance of such p ecautions the use of the insecticide involves se ious isk to human beings or animals it may efuse to egiste the insecticide.

[(3-A) In the case of applications eceived by it prio to the 31st day of Ma ch, 1975, notwithstanding the expi y of the pe iod specified in sub-section (3) for disposal of such applications, it shall be lawful and shall be deemed always to have been lawful fo the Regist ation Committee to dispose of such applications at any time afte such expi y but within a pe iod of one yea f om the commencement of the Insecticides (Amendment) Act, 1977 (24 of 1977):

P ovided that nothing contained in this sub-section shall be deemed to make any cont avention before the commencement of the Insecticides (Amendment) Act, 1977 (24 of 1977), of a condition of a ce tificate of egist ation g anted befo e such commencement, an offence punishable unde this Act.

(3-B) Whe e the Regist ation Committee is of opinion that the insecticide is being int oduced for the fi st time in India, it may, pending any enqui y, egiste it p ovisionally, fo a pe iod of two yeas on such conditions as may be specified by it.

(3-C) The Regist ation Committee may, having ega d to the efficacy of the insecticide and its safety to human beings and animals, vay the conditions subject to which a ce tificate or egist ation has been g anted and may for that pu pose equi e the ce tificate holde by notice in writing to delive up the ce tificate to it within such time as may be specified in the notice]

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in this section, whe e an insecticide has been egiste ed on the application of any pe son, any othe pe son desi ing to import or manufactu e the insecticide or engaged in the business of, import or manufactu e the eof shall on application and on payment of p esc ibed fee be allotted a egist ation numbe and g anted a ce tificate of egist ation in espect the eof on the same conditions on which the insecticide was originally egiste ed.

10. Appeal against non- egist ation o cancellation

Any pe son agg ieved by a decision of the Regist ation Committee unde Sec. 9 may, within a pe iod of thi ty days f om the date on which the decision is communicated to him appeal in the p esc ibed manne and on payment of the p esc ibed fee to the Cent al Gove nment whose decision the eon shall be final:

P ovided that the Cent al Gove nment may ente tain an appeal afte the expi y of the said pe iod, if it is satisfied that the appellant was p evented by sufficient cause f om filing the appeal in time.

11. Powe of evision of Cent al Gove nment

The Cent al Gove nment may, at any time, call for the eco d elating to any case in which the Regist ation Committee has given a decision unde Sec. 9 fo the pu pose of satisfying itself as to the legality o p op iety of any such decision and may pass any such orde in elation the eto as it thinks fit:

P ovided that no such orde shall be passed afte the expi y of one yea f om the date of the decision:

P ovided fu the that the Cent al Gove nment shall not pass any o de p ejudicial to any pe son unless that pe son has had a easonable oppo tunity of showing cause against the p oposed o de .

12. Licensing office s

The State Gove nment may, by notification in the official Gazette, appoint such pe sons as it thinks fit to be licensing office s for the pu poses of this Act and define the a eas in espect of which they shall exe cise ju isdiction.

13. G ant of license

1. Any pe son desi ing to manufactu e or to sell, stock or exhibit fo sale or dist ibute any insecticide, [o to unde take comme cial pest cont ol ope ations with the use of any insecticide] may make an application to the licensing office fo the g ant of a license:

P ovided that any pe son engaged in the business of manufactu ing o selling, stocking o exhibiting fo sale or dist ibuting any insecticide immediately before the commencement of this section shall make an application to licensing office for the g ant of a license within a pe iod of [seventeen months] f om the date of such commencement:

P ovided fu the that any pe son engaged in the comme cial pest cont ol ope ations immediately before the commencement of the Insecticides (Amendment) Act, 1977 (24 of 1977), shall make an application to the licensing office for the g ant of a license within a pe iod of six months f om the commencement of the said Act].

- 2. Eve y application unde sub-section (1) shall be made in such form and shall contain such pa ticula s as may be p esc ibed.
- 3. On eccept of any such application for the g ant of a license, the licensing office may g ant a license in such form, on such conditions and on payment of such fee as may be p esc ibed.
- 4. A license g anted unde this section shall be valid fo the pe iod specified the ein and may be enewed f om time to time fo such pe iod and on payment of such fee as may be p esc ibed:

P ovided that whe e a license has been g anted to any pe son who has made an application unde [the fi st p oviso or, as the case may be the second p ovision to sub-section (1), that license shall be deemed to be cancelled in elation to any insecticide the application for egist ation whe eof has been efused or the egist ation whe eof has been cancelled, unde this Act, with effect f om the date on which such efusal o cancellation is notified in official Gazette.

5. In p esc ibed fees for the g ant or enewal of licenses unde this section, diffe ent fees may be p esc ibed fo the sale or dist ibution of insecticides for pu poses of domestic use and for othe pu poses.

14. Revocation, suspension and amendment of licenses

1. If the licensing office is satisfied, eithe on a refe ence made to him in this behalf or othe wise, that *

- a. The license g anted unde Sec. 13 has been g anted because of mis ep esentation as to an essential fact; o
- b. The holde of a license has failed to comply with the conditions subject to which the license was g anted o has cont avened any of the p ovisions of this Act o the ules made the e unde ,
- 2. Then, without p ejudice to any othe penalty to which the holde of the license may be liable unde this Act, the licensing office may, afte giving the holde of the license an opportunity of showing cause, evoke or suspend the license.

Subject to any ules that may be made in this behalf, the licensing office may also va y or amend a license g anted unde Sec. 13.

15. Appeal against the decision of a licensing office

1. Any pe son agg ieved by a decision of licensing office unde Sec. 13 [expect unde the p oviso to sub-section (4)] o Sec. 14 may, within a pe iod of thi ty days f om the date on which the decision is communicated to him, appeal to such authority in such manne and on payment of such fees as may be p esc ibed:

P ovided that the appellate authority may ente tain an appeal the expi y of the said pe iod if it is satisfied that the appellant was p evented by sufficient cause fo filing the appeal in time.

2. On ecceipt of an appeal unde sub-section (1), the appellate autho ity shall, afte giving the appellant an opportunity of showing cause; dispose of the appeal ordina ily within a pe iod of six months and the decision of the appellant authority shall be final.

16. Cent al Insecticides Labo ato y

The Cent al Gove nment may, by notification in the official Gazette, establish a Cent al Insecticides Laborato y unde the cont ol of Di ector to be appointed by the Cent al Gove nment to ca y out the functions ent usted to it by or unde this Act:

P ovided that if the Cent al Gove nment so di ects by a notification in the official Gazette, the functions of the Cent al Insecticides Laboratory shall, to such extent as may be specified in the notification, be ca ied out at any such institution as may be specified the ein and the eupon the functions of the Di ecto of the Cent al Insecticides Laboratory shall to the extent so specified, be exe cised by the head of the institution.

17. P ohibition of impo t and manufactu e of ce tain insecticides

- 1. No pe son shall, himself or by any pe son on his behalf, impo t o manufactu e \ast
 - b. Any misb anded insecticide;
 - a. Any insecticide the sale, dist ibution o use of which is for the time being p ohibited unde Sec. 27;
 - b. Any insecticide except in accordance with the conditions on which it was egiste ed;
 - c. any insecticide in cont avention of any othe p ovision of this Act or of any ule made the e unde ;

P ovided that any pe son who has applied for egist ation of an insecticide [unde any of the p ovisos] to sub-section (1) of Sec. 9 may continue to impo t or manufactu e any such insecticide any such insecticide shall not be deemed to be a misb anded insecticide within the meaning of sub-section (vi) or sub-clause (vii) or sub-clause (viii) of Cl. (k) of Sec. 3, until he has been informed by the Regist ation Committee of its decision to efuse to egiste the said insecticide.

2. No pe son shall, himself or by any pe son on his behalf; manufactu e any insecticide except unde , and in accordance with the conditions of, a license issued for such pu pose unde this Act.

18. P ohibition of sale, etc. of ce tain insecticides

- 1. No pe son shall, himself o by any pe son on his behalf, sell, stock o exhibit for sale, dist ibute [t anspo t, use or cause to be used] by any worke :
 - a. Any insecticide which is not egiste ed unde this Act;
 - b. Any insecticide, the sale, dist ibution o use of which is fo the time being p ohibited unde Sec. 27;
 - c. Any insecticide in cont avention of any othe p ovision of this Act or of any ule made the e unde .
- 2. No pe son shall, himself o by any pe son on his behalf, sell, stock o exhibit for sale o dist ibute [o use fo comme cial pest control ope ations] any insecticide except unde , and in accordance with the conditions of, a license issued for such pu pose unde this Act.

Explanation

Fo the pu poses of this section an insecticide in espect of which any pe son has applied for a ce tificate of egist ation [unde any of the p ovisos] to sub-section (1) of Sec. 9, shall be deemed to be egiste ed till the date on which the efusal to egiste such insecticide is notified in the official Gazette.

19. Insecticide Analysts

The Cent al Gove nment o a State Gove nment may, by notification in the official Gazette,_appoint pe sons in such numbe as it thinks fit and possessing such technical and othe qualifications as may be p esc ibed to be Insecticide Analysts for such a eas and in espect of such insecticides o class of insecticides as may be specified in the notification:

P ovided that no pe son who has any financial inte est in the manufactu e, import or sale of any insecticide, shall be so appointed.

20. Insecticide Inspecto s

1. The Cent al Gove nment o a State Gove nment may, by notification in the official Gazette, appoint pe sons in such numbe as it thinks fit and possessing such technical and othe qualifications as may be p esc ibed to be Insecticide Inspectors for such a eas as may be specified in the notification:

P ovided that any pe son who does not possess the equi ed qualifications may be so appointed only for the pu poses of Cls. (a) and (d) of sub-section (1) of Sec. 21.

P ovided fu the that no pe son who has any financial inte est in the manufactu e, import or sale of any insecticide shall be so appointed.

2. Eve y Insecticide Inspecto shall be deemed to be a public se vant within the meaning of Sec. 21 of the Indian Penal Code (45 of 1860), and shall be officially subordinate to such autho ity as the Gove nment appointing him may specify in this behalf.

21. Powe s of Insecticide Inspecto s

- 1. An Insecticide Inspector shall have powe :
 - a. to ente and sea ch, at all easonable times and with such assistance, if any, as he conside s necessa y, any p emises in which he has eason to believe that an offence unde this Act o the ules made the e unde has been or is being o is about to be committed, o for the pu pose of satisfying himself that the p ovisions of this Act or the ules made the e unde or the conditions of any ce tificate of egist ation or license issued the e unde a e being complied with;
 - b. to equi e the p oduction of, and to inspect, examine and make copies of, or take ext acts f om, egiste s, ecords or othe documents kept by a manufactu e, dist ibutor, ca ie, deale or any othe pe son in pu suance of the p ovisions of this Act or the ules made the e unde and seize the same, if he has eason to believe that all or any of them may fu nish evidence of the commission of an offence punishable unde this Act o the ules made the e unde ;
 - c. to make such examination and inqui y as he thinks fit in o de to asce tain whethe the p ovisions of this Act o the ules made the e unde a e being complied with and for the pu pose stop any vehicle;
 - d. to stop the dist ibution, sale o use of an insecticide which he has eason to believe is being dist ibuted, sold o used in cont avention of the p ovisions of this Act or the ules made the e unde , for a specified pe iod not exceeding twenty days, or unless the alleged cont avention is such that the defect may be emoved by the possesso of the insecticide, seize the stock of such insecticide;
 - e. to take samples of any insecticide and send such samples for analysis to the Insecticide Analyst fo test in the p esc ibed manne ; and
 - f. to exe cise such othe powe s as may be necessa y for ca ying out the pu poses of this Act or the ules made the e unde .
- 2. The p ovisions of the Code of C iminal P ocedu e, 1973 (2 of 1974), shall, as fa as may be, apply to any sea ch or seizu e unde this Act as they apply to any sea ch or seizu e made unde the autho ity of a wa ant issued unde Sec. 94 of the said code.
- 3. An Insecticide Inspector may exe cise the powe s of a police office unde [Sec. 42 of the Code of C iminal P ocedu e, 1973 (2 of 1974)], fo the pu pose of asce taining

the t ue name and esidence of the pe son f om whom a sample is taken or insecticide is seized.

22. P ocedu e to be followed by Insecticide Inspecto s

- 1. Whe e an Insecticide Inspecto seizes any ecord, egiste o document unde Cl. (b) sub-section (1) of Sec. 21, he shall, as soon as may be info m a Magist ate and take his orde s as to the custody the eof.
- 2. Whe e an Insecticide Inspector takes any action unde Cl. (d) of sub-section (1) of Sec. 21
 - a. he shall use all dispatch in asce taining whethe or not the insecticide or its sale, dist ibution o use cont avenes any of the p ovisions of Sec. 18 and if it is asce tained that the insecticide o its sale, dist ibution o use does not so cont avene, forthwith evoke the orde passed unde the said clause o, as the case may be, take such action as may be necessa y for the etu n of the stock seized;
 - b. if he seizes the stock of the insecticide he shall, as soon as may be, info m a Magist ate and take his orde s as to the custody the eof;
 - c. without p ejudice to the institution of any p osecution, if the alleged cont avention be such that the defect may be emedied by the possesso of the insecticide, he shall, on being satisfied that the defect has been so emedied, forthwith evoke his orde and in case whe e the Insecticide Inspector has seized the stock of insecticide, he shall, as soon as may be, inform a Magist ate and obtain his o de as the elease the eof.
- 3. Whe e an Insecticide Inspecto takes any sample of an insecticide, he shall tende the fai p ice the eof and may equi e a w itten acknowledgement the efo e.
- Whe e the p ice tende ed unde sub-section (3) is efused, o whe e the Insecticide Inspector seizes the stock of any insecticide unde Cl. (d) of sub-section (1) of Sec. 21 he shall tende a eceipt the efore in the p esc ibed form.
- 5. Whe e an Insecticide Inspector takes a sample of any insecticide for the pu pose of test o analysis, he shall intimate such pu pose in w iting in the p esc ibed form to the pe son f om whom he takes it, and in the p esence of such pe son unless he willfully absents himself, shall divide the sample into the period and effectively seal and suitably ma k the same and pe mit such pe son to add his own seal and ma k to all or any of the po tion so sealed and ma ked.

P ovided that whe e the insecticide is made up in containe s of small volume, instead of dividing a sample as aforesaid, the Insecticide Inspector may, and if the insecticide be such, that it is likely to dete iorate o be othe wise damaged by exposu e shall take th ee of the said containe s after suitably ma king the same and, whe e necessary, sealing them.

- 6. The insecticide inspector shall estore one po tion of a sample so divided or mo e one containe , as the case may be, to the pe son f om whom he takes it and shall etain the emainde and dispose of the same as follows:
 - a. one po tion or containe , he shall fo thwith send to the Insecticide Analyst for test or analysis; and
 - b. the second, he shall p oduce to the Cou t befo e which p oceedings, if any, a e instituted in espect of the insecticide.

23. Pe sons bound to disclose place whe e insecticides a e manufactu ed o kept *

Eve y pe son for the time being in cha ge of any p emises whe e any insecticide is being manufactu ed or is kept for sale or dist ibution shall, on being equi ed by an Insecticide Inspector so to do, be legally bound to disclose to the Insecticide Inspector the place whe e the insecticide is being manufactu ed or is kept, as the case may be.

24. Repot of Insecticide Analyst

- 1. The Insecticide Analyst to whom a sample of any insecticide has been submitted for test or analysis unde sub-section (6) of Sec. 22, shall, within a pe iod of sixty days, delive y to the Insecticide Inspector submitting it a signed epo t in duplicate in the p esc ibed form.
- 2. The Insecticide Inspecto on eceipt the eof shall delive one copy of the epot to the pe son f om whom the sample was taken and shall etain the othe copy for use in any p osecution in espect of the sample.
- 3. Any document pu porting to be a eport signed by an Insecticide Analyst shall be evidence of facts stated the ein, and such evidence shall be conclusive unless the pe son f om whom the sample was taken has within twenty-eight days of the eceipt of a copy of the eport notified in w iting the Insecticide Inspector o the Cou t befo e which any p oceeding in espect of the sample a e pending that he intends to adduce evidence in cont avention of the epo t.
- 4. Unless the sample has all eady been tested of analyzed in the Cent al Insecticides Laborato y, where a person has under sub-section (3) notified his intention of adducing evidence in contravention of the insecticide analysts eport the Court may, of its own motion or its discretion at the equest either of the complainant or of the accused, cause the sample of the insecticide produced before the Magistrate unde sub-section (6) of Sec. 22 to be sent for test or analysis to the laboratory, which shall make the test or analysis and eport in writing signed by, or under the authority of, the Director of Cent al Insecticides Laboratory the esult the eof, and such eport shall be conclusive evidence of the facts stated the ein.
- 5. The cost of a test o analysis made by the Cent al Insecticides Laborato y unde subsection (4) shall be paid by the complainant or the accused as the Cou t shall di ect.

25. Confiscation

- 1. Whe e any pe son has been convicted unde this Act fo cont avening any of the p ovisions of this Act o of the ules made the e unde , the stock of the insecticide in espect of which the cont avention has been made shall be liable to confiscation.
- 2. Without p ejudice to the p ovisions contained in sub-section (1), whe e the Cou t is satisfied on the application of an Insecticide Inspecto or othe wise and afte such inqui y as may be necessa y, that the insecticide is a misb anded insecticide, such insecticide shall be liable to confiscation.

26. Notification of poisoning

The State Gove nment may, by notification in the official Gazette, equi e any pe son or class of pe sons specified the ein to epo t all occu ences of poisoning (th ough the use

or handling of any insecticide) coming within his or thei cognizance to such office as may be specified in the said notification.

27. P ohibition of sale, etc. of insecticide fo easons of public safety

1. If, on eccipt of a epo t unde Sec. 26 o othe wise, the Cent al Gove nment o the State Gove nment is of opinion, fo easons to be ecorded in w iting, that the use of any insecticide specified in sub-clause (iii) of Cl. (e) of Sec. 3 o any specific batch the eof is likely to involve such isk to human beings or animals as to ende it expedient or necessa y to take immediate action then that Gove nment may, by notification in the official Gazette, p ohibit the sale, dist ibution or use of the insecticide o batch, in such a eas, to such extent and for such pe iod (not exceeding sixty days) as may be specified in the notification pending investigation into the matte :

P ovided that whe e the investigation is not completed within the said pe iod, the Cent al Gove nment o the State Gove nment, as the case may be, may extend it by such fu the pe iod or pe iods not exceeding thi ty days in the agg egate as it may specify in a like manne .

2. If, as a esult of its own investigation or on eccipt of the epot f om the State Gove nment, is satisfied that the use of the said insecticide o batch is or is not likely to cause any such isk, it may pass such orde (including an orde efusing to egiste to egiste the insecticide or canceling the ce tificate of egist ation, if any, g anted in espect the eof) as it deems fit, depending on the ci cumstances of the case.

28. Notification of cancellation of egist ation, etc.

A efusal to egiste any insecticide or a cancellation of a ce tificate of egist ation of any insecticide shall be notified in the official Gazette and in such othe manne as may be p esc ibed.

29. Offences and punishment

- 1. Whoeve,
 - a. imports, manufactu es, sells, stocks o exhibits for sale o dist ibutes any insecticide deemed to be misb anded unde sub-clause (i) or sub-clause (iii) or sub-clause (viii) of Cl. (k) of Sec. 3 o
 - Impo ts or manufactu es any insecticide without a ce tificate of egist ation; or
 - c. Manufactu es, sells, stocks o exhibits for sale or dist ibutes an insecticide without a license; or
 - d. Sells or dist ibutes an insecticide, in cont avention of Sec. 27; o
 - e. Causes an insecticide, the use of which has been p ohibited unde Sec. 27, to be used by any worke ; o
 - i. Obst ucts an Insecticide Inspector in the exe cise of his powe s o discha ge of his duties unde this Act, o the ules made the e unde , shall be punishable *

- ii. Fo the fi st offence, with imp isonment for a te m which may extend to two yea s, or with fine which may extend to two thousand upees, o with both;
- iii. Fo the second and a subsequent offence, with imp isonment fo a tem which may extend to the e yea s, o with fine, or with both.
- 2. Whoeve uses an insecticide in cont avention of any p ovision of this Act o any ule made the e unde shall be punishable with fine, which may extend to five hund ed upees.
- 3. Whoeve cont avenes any of the othe p ovisions of this Act o any ule made the e unde o any condition of ce tificate of egist ation or license g anted the e unde , shall be punishable *
 - a. Fo the fi st offence, with imp isonment fo a te m which may extend to six months, or with fine o with both;
 - b. Fo the second and a subsequent offence, with imp isonment for a te m which may extend to one yea , o with fine or with both.
- 4. If any pe son convicted of an offence unde this Act commits a like offence afte wa ds it shall be lawful fo the Cou t before which the second or subsequent conviction takes place to cause the offende *s name and place of esidence, the offence and the penalty imposed to be published in such newspape s or in such othe manne as the Cou t may di ect.

30. Defense which may o may not be allowed in p osecutions unde this Act

- Save as he einafte p ovided in this section, it shall be no defense in a p osecution unde this Act to p ove me ely that the accused was ignorant of the natu e o quality of the insecticide in espect of which the offence was committed or of the isk involved in the manufactu e, sale or use of such insecticide or of the ci cumstances of its manufactu e o impo t.
- 2. Fo the pu poses of Sec. 17 an insecticide shall not be deemed to be misb anded only by eason of the fact that *
 - a. the e has been added the eto some innocuous substance or ing edient because the same is equi ed for the manufactu e or the p epa ation of the insecticide as an a ticle of comme ce in a state fit for ca iage or consumption, and not to inc ease the bulk, weight or measu e of the insecticide o to conceal its infe ior quality or othe defect; o
 - b. In the p ocess of manufactu e, p epa ation or conveyance some ext aneous substance has unavoidably become inte mixed with it.
- 3. A pe son not being an importe or a manufactu e of an insecticide or his agent for the dist ibution the eof, shall not be liable for cont avention of any p ovision of this Act, if he p oves *

- a. That he acqui ed the insecticide f om an impo te or a duly licensed manufactu e , dist ibutor or deale the eof;
- b. That he did not know and could not, with easonable diligence, have asce tained that the insecticide in any way cont avened any p ovision of this Act; and
- c. That the insecticide, while in his possession, was p ope ly sto ed and emained in the same state as when he acqui ed it.

31. Cognizance and t ial of Offences

- 1. No p osecution fo an offence unde this Act shall be instituted except by or with the w itten consent of, the State Gove nment or a pe son authorized in this behalf by the State Gove nment.
- 2. No Cou t infe ior to that of a [Met opolitan Magist ate o a Judicial Magist ate of the fi st class] shall t y any offence unde this Act.

32. [Magist ate*s powe to impose enhanced penalties] Rep. By Act 24 of 1977 Sec. 8.

33. Offences by Companies

 Wheneve an offence unde this Act has been committed by a company, eve y pe son who at the time the offence was committed was in cha ge of, or was esponsible to the company for the conduct of the business of the company, as well as the company, shall be deemed to be guilty of the offence and shall be liable to be p oceeded against and punished accordingly:

P ovided that nothing contained in this sub-section shall ende any such pe son liable to any punishment unde this Act if he p oves that the offence was committed without his knowledge or that he exe cised all due diligence to p event the commission of such offence.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1), whe e an offence unde this Act has been committed by a company and it is p oved that the offence has been committed with the consent o connivance of, o is att ibutable to any neglect, on the pat of, any di ector, manage, sec eta y or othe office of the company, such di ecto, manage, sec eta y or othe office shall also be deemed to be guilty of that offence and shall be liable to be p oceeded against and punished accordingly.

Explanation

Fo - the pu pose of this section:

- i. "Company" means any body corpo ate and includes a fi m o othe association of individuals; and
- ii. "Di ector" in elation to a fi m, means a pa tne in the fi m.

34. Powe of the Cent al Gove nment to give di ections

The Cent al Gove nment may give such di ections to any State Gove nment as may appea to the Cent al Gove nment to be necessa y for ca ying into execution in the State any of the p ovisions of this Act o of any ule or o de made the e unde .

35. P otection of action taken in good faith

No p osecution, suit o othe p oceeding shall lie against the Gove nment, o any office of the Gove nment, o the Boa d, the Regist ation Committee or any Committee of the Boa d, fo anything in good faith done or intended to be done unde this Act.

36. Powe of the Cent al Gove nment to make ules

1. The Cent al Gove nment may, afte consultation with the Boa d and subject to the condition of p evious publication, by notification in the official Gazette, make ules for the pu pose of giving effect to the p ovisions of this Act;

P ovided that consultation with the Boa d may be dispensed with if the Cent al Gove nment is of opinion that ci cumstances have a isen which ende it necessa y to make ules without such consultation, but in such a case the Boa d shall be consulted within six months of the making of the ules and the Cent al Gove nment shall take into conside ation any suggestions which the Boa d may make in elation to the amendment of the said ules.

- 2. In pa ticula and without p ejudice to the gene ality of the fo egoing powe , such ules may p esc ibe *
 - i. The method of packing and labeling;
 - ii. The manne of egist ation of an insecticide;
 - iii. the functions of the Boa d and of the Regist ation Committee and the t aveling and othe allowance payable to membe s of the Boa d, the Regist ation Committee and any Committee of the Boa d;
- iv. The places at which insecticides may be imported and p ohibit thei impo t at any othe place;
- v. The form of application for egist ation of an insecticide and the pa ticula s elating the eto;
- vi. The fee payable in espect of the egist ation
- vii. The manne of appeal to the Cent al Gove nment unde Sec. 10 and fee payable the efore;
- viii. The form of application fo the g ant of license and the pa ticula s elating the eto;
- ix. The form of license, the conditions attached the eto and the fee payable the efo e;
- x. The pe iod fo which a license may be enewed and the fee for such enewal;
- xi. The ci cumstances in which a license may be valied or amended unde sub-section (2) of Sec. 14.
- xii. The functions of the Cent al Insecticides Laborato y;
- xiii. The qualifications, powe s and duties of an Insecticide Analyst and an Insecticide Inspector.

- xiv. The manne of testing or analyzing the samples of any insecticide and the fee payable the efore;
- xv. The form in which intimation shall be given by an Insecticide Inspecto unde subsection (5) of Sec. 22 to a pe son f om whom a sample of an Insecticide is taken for test or analysis;
- xvi. The form in which the Insecticide Analyst shall submit a epot of his test or analysis to the Insecticide Inspector unde sub-section (1) of Sec. 24;
- xvii. The p otective clothing and equipment to be used by wo kes du ing the manufactu e, formulation, t anspo t, dist ibution and application of insecticides and othe facilities to be p ovided to keep themselves and thing supplied to them f ee f om any contamination;
- xviii. The use by the worke s of any such p otective clothing, equipment and othe facilities;
- xix. The p ecautions to be taken against poisoning th ough the use o handling of insecticides;
- xx. The measules for detecting and investigating cases in which poisoning has occuled;
- xxi. The facilities to be p ovided fo ensu ing fi st-aid t eatment;
- xxii. The inst uction and t aining to be p ovided ega ding the use of things supplied to the worke s for ensu ing thei safety;
- xxiii. The facilities fo medical examination of wo kes engaged in the manufactu e or handling of insecticides;
- xxiv. The equipment for and method of application of, an insecticide and the disposal of su plus mate ial, washings and containe s, following application;
- xxv. The maintenance and inspection of eco ds and etu ns;
- xxvi. The est ictions on storage of insecticides du ing t ansport or, othe wise along with a ticles of food;
- xxvii. The maximum p oportion of any insecticide which may be added to o contained in, any p epa ation fo domestic use and the est iction the eon;
- xxviii. The manne in which efusal to egiste an insecticide or cancellation of ce tificate of egist ation the eof may be notified;
- xxix. The office or authority to whom the Cent al Gove nment may delegate any of the powe s and functions confe ed on it by this Act;
- xxx. any othe matte which has to be p esc ibed.
- 3. Eve y ule made by the Cent al Gove nment unde this Act shall be laid, as soon as may be afte it is made, before each House of Pa liament, while it is in session fo a total pe iod of thi ty days which may be comp ised in one session [or in two or mo e successive sessions, and if, befo e the expi y of the session immediately following the session or the successive sessions aforesaid], both Houses ag ee in making any modification in the ule o both Houses ag ee that the ule should not be made, the ule shall the eafte have effect only in such modified form or be of no effect, as the

case may be; so howeve that any such modification or annulment shall be without p ejudice to the validity of anything p eviously done unde that ule.

37. Powe of the State Gove nment to make ules

- 1. The State Gove nment may, afte consultation with the Boa d and subject to the condition of p evious publication, by notification in the official Gazette make ules for the pu pose of giving effect to the p ovisions of this Act and not consistent with the ules, if any, made by the Cent al Gove nment.
- 2. In pa ticula and without p ejudice to the gene ality of the fo egoing powe , such ules may p ovide for $\ensuremath{^*}$
 - a. The authority to which, the manne in which, and the fee on payment of which, an appeal may be filed unde Sec. 15 and the p ocedu e to be followed by the appellate authority in disposing of the appeal;
 - b. The delegation of any of the powe s and functions confe ed by this Act on the State Gove nment to any office or authority specified by that Gove nment.

38. Exemption

- 1. Nothing in this Act shall apply to:
 - a. the use of any insecticide by any pe son for his own household pu poses o for ga den or in espect of any land unde his cultivation;
 - b. Any substance specified or included in the schedule or any p epa ation containing any one o more such substances, if such substance or p epa ation is intended for pu poses othe than p eventing, dest oying, epelling or mitigating any insects, odents, fungi, weeds and othe forms of plant o animal life not useful to human beings.
- 2. The Cent al Gove nment may, by notification in the official Gazette, and subject to such conditions, if any, as it may specify the ein, exempt f om all or any of the p ovisions of this Act or the ules made the e unde , any educational, scientific or esea ch o ganization engaged in ca ying out expe iments with insecticides.
